Directions to the Ernest N. Morial Convention Center

General Directions from the East

Take I-10 West to Exit 234C (West Bank/Highway 90).

Continue on Highway 90 (the Riverfront Expressway) and exit right at Tchoupitoulas/South Peters Street. This is the last exit before crossing the bridge!

On ground level, stay in the left lane and go to the fourth stop, which is Convention Center Boulevard. You will see the Convention Center Expansion in front of you.

Turn left on Convention Center Boulevard.

The Convention Center is on your right, at 900 Convention Center Boulevard.

General Directions from the West

Take I-10 East to the West Bank/Highway 90 exit (do not continue on I-10 to Slidell).

Stay in the right lane and exit right at Tchoupitoulas/South Peters Street. This is the last exit before crossing the bridge!

On ground level, stay in the left lane and go to the fourth stop, which is Convention Center Boulevard. You will see the Convention Center Expansion in front of you.

Turn left on Convention Center Boulevard.

The Convention Center is on your right, at 900 Convention Center Boulevard.

Parking

The Convention Center has no parking of its own. The committee is researching the possibility of obtaining additional parking. Look for a re-posting of the document with more information as the event nears. Park only in legal spaces (more than 20 feet from any curb) on surrounding city streets, or you may be ticketed and towed!
