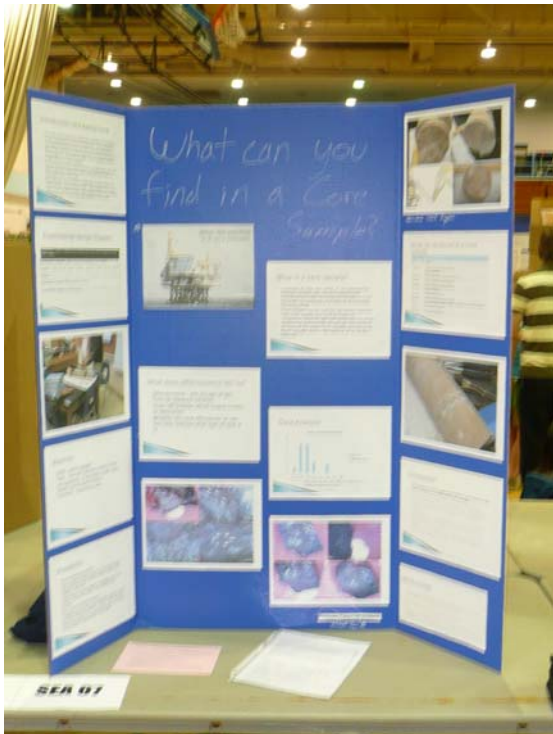


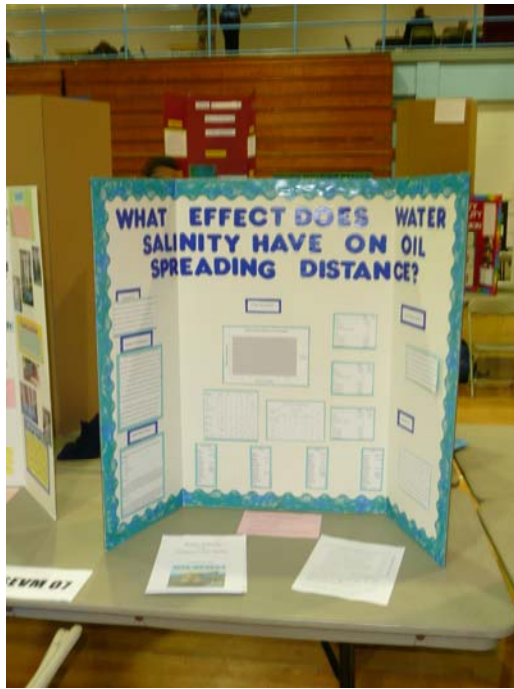
2010 GNOSEF

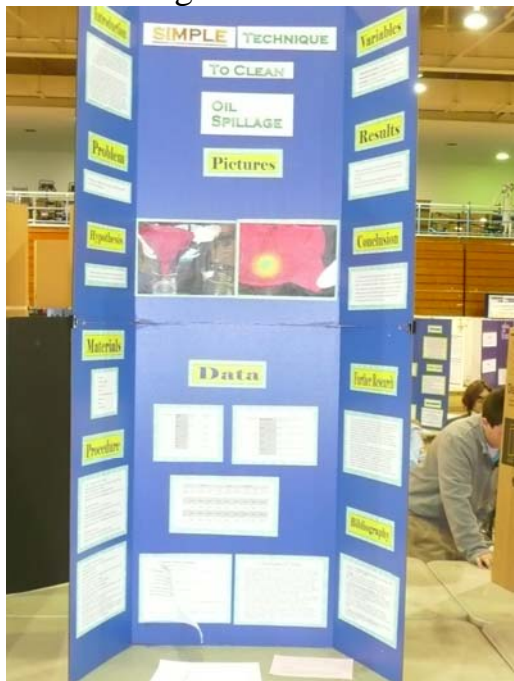
