SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The American Petroleum Institute – Delta Chapter will offer scholarships for 2012 – 2013. The goal of the API – Delta Chapter scholarship program is to help students of exceptional promise reach their full potential through education. - Applicant must be a full-time student with a minimum of 12 semester hours.
